VICTORIA



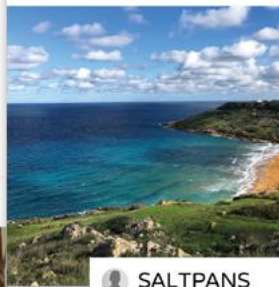
